The Jewish Continuity Project
for
Summer Camps

As approved by the Scholarship and Endowment Fund Committee on April 11, 2001

Rationale

Associated Hebrew Schools of Toronto's Scholarship and Endowment Fund Committee allocates money to students requiring financial assistance to participate in programmes of Jewish education. The **Jewish Continuity Project for Summer Camps** provides scholarships to qualifying children who are continuing/ furthering their Jewish educational experience at a summer camp recognized for its Jewish programming. This project helps children enjoy the experience of Jewish immersion while relieving some of the financial burden on the family.

Eligibility Criteria

1. Associated Hebrew Schools students
2. Attend a **recognized Jewish summer camp**
3. **Receiving financial assistance from the camp.**

Eligible Camps

1. Overnight camps, recognized for their Jewish programming.
2. Overnight camps which substantially enhance the *quantitative* aspects of Jewish social, cultural and religious experience;

Process

Applicants may be eligible to receive a Matching Fund Grant, the amount contingent upon the total funds available at the time of allocation. Applicants must complete a simple form and **provide evidence of receipt of financial assistance** from their respective camp. Staff will verify each case and recommendations will be presented to the Committee.

Camp programmes must be approved by Associated Hebrew Schools of Toronto's Educational Staff.

Awards

Awardees receive notice that a financial assistance award will be granted and paid directly to the camp, on proof of completion of attendance, not before the start of the camp season.

DEADLINE FOR APPLICATION

All submissions for assistance should be made by **March 31** and be fully completed. Notice of the scholarship grant will be forthcoming normally no later than June 1 of the same year.

LATE APPLICATIONS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.

APPLICATION REQUESTS

Requests for scholarship consideration may only be made by submitting an application available from the Committee.
